### This is PROKON

Product Control for Agricultural (Prokon) is a registered non-profit company under the Companies Act, No. 71 of 2008 that renders a quality assurance service at key inspection points, i.e., fresh produce markets, distribution centres, wholesalers, retail outlets as well as inland and seaports of entry.

In terms of its appointment as an official assignee of the Department of Agriculture, Prokon has been rendering a comprehensive inspection service for more than 30 years in accordance with the Agricultural Products Standards Act, No. 119 of 1990 and the relevant product regulations. It has been conducting unofficial inspections under contract for various fresh produce industries and retail groups since 2012.

In 2021 Prokon received the internationally recognised ISO/IEC 17020 accreditation from the South African National Accreditation System (SANAS) for the inspection of fresh produce in South Africa at fresh produce markets, in retail outlets and at ports of entry. Following the compliance assessment of Prokon by SANAS on 10 October 2024 it successfully passed the requirements and was granted accreditation for a fourth successive year.

# Scope of work

Prokon conducts quality assurance inspections on produce intended for sale in in the Republic of South Africa in accordance with the relevant product regulations and the company's SANAS ISO 17020 accreditation with the emphasis on compliance with the:

- Mandate given by the Department of Agriculture to ensure consumer protection and instil consumer confidence in the quality and consumption of regulated fresh produce.
- Standard operating procedures (SOPs) and quality management system (QMS) in terms of its SANAS accreditation.

During inspections the inspectors, e.g., check for the following based on the regulation applicable to the specific product:

- Marking requirement conformity on packaging.
- External and internal quality.
- Size
- Ripeness and firmness.

### Fee structure

- Prokon operates on a cost recovery basis and the determination of the fees is based on objectivity, fairness and reasonableness.
